THE GROVE PRIMARY SCHOOL GENDER POLICY

- o The Grove Primary is committed to co-educational schooling.
- o The school aims as far as possible at a 50-50 split between the genders in each grade.
- o The Grove strives to fulfill the potential of each of its children, male and female.
- o All pupils, teachers and parents are to be treated equally in terms of gender.
- o As a co-educational school The Grove caters for the specific needs of each gender in terms of learning style, emotional needs, sports and activities, facilities and uniform.
- o Pupils should not be restricted as a result of their gender from participating in any activity without good reason.
- o The school commits itself to being sensitive to gender issues and raising awareness thereof, striving to avoid the use of stereotypes and generalisation around gender roles.

This policy covers transgender persons and protects gender non-binary, gender fluid and gender nonconforming persons too.
