

SIFTING PROCESS

RESIDENCY QUALIFICATION

Learners residing permanently with their parents/legal guardians/guardians nominated by official bodies and whose closest public primary school is The Grove, by distance, will be considered above all others for admission. Appropriate proof of residence will be required, in the form of a rates account not older than 3 months or a certified copy of the current lease agreement (in the case of renting of property).

ADMISSION OF LEARNERS – NOT CLOSEST TO SCHOOL

Factors which can be taken into account when considering placement include:

- Children of permanent full time employees of the The Grove Primary school.
- Permanent full time employment within the vicinity of The Grove Primary i.e. The closest public primary school to your physical work address is The Grove, by distance. A letter on your company letterhead, dated, signed and stamped confirming your current employment and start date with the company would be required.
- While siblings of learners for whom the school is not the closest will be considered, they **will not** automatically be granted admission.
- Learners for whom the school is not the closest will be considered once those who qualify in terms of the above have been accommodated.
- Relocations - families moving into the area from other areas/provinces/countries where The Grove is the closest public primary school. Appropriate proof of residence will be required, in the form of a rates account not older than 3 months or a certified copy of the current lease agreement (in the case of renting of property). If these are not available at the time of application we require compelling evidence of intention to move and to reside within reasonable proximity of the school. Any place offered in these circumstances would be provisional in nature and can be rescinded if the suitable proof of residence is not provided before the learner starts at the school.
